## BYLAW NUMBER 12/2016

# BEING A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF DAUPHIN TO PROVIDE FOR COMPLIANCE OF BYLAWS

**WHEREAS** Section 232(1) (0) of *The Municipal Act* allows municipalities to pass a bylaw to enforce bylaws of that municipality;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 236(1) of *The Municipal Act* allows for municipalities to include provisions in a bylaw to create fines for committing offences, which can be collected in any manner in which a tax may be collected or enforced under the *Act*;

**AND WHEREAS** it is deemed expedient and in the public interest to provide a bylaw allowing a designated officer who believes that a person has committed an offence to issue a fine;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 249(2) of *The Municipal Act* indicates that when a contravention continues for more than one day, the person is guilty of a separate offence each day it continues;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Dauphin, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw is known as the Compliance Bylaw.
- 2. Anyone who contravenes, or does not comply, or improperly complies, or only partly complies with any provision of a bylaw of the City of Dauphin commits an offence. Without restricting the generality of the foregoing, Schedule A hereto contains the listing of offences which qualify as compliance violations. Violations that fall under the "other" category as listed in Schedule A hereto shall include but not be limited to the offences as set out in Schedule B hereto.
- 3. Anyone who commits an offence as indicated in Item 2 of this bylaw is guilty of that offence and is liable to a fine as set out in this bylaw, the City of Dauphin's Fees and Charges Bylaw, and/or any other bylaw of the City of Dauphin.
- 4. The following procedure shall apply for offences committed under Item 2 of this bylaw:
  - a. A designated officer may issue a Fine Notice of bylaw violation, in a form as set out in Schedule C hereto, levying the applicable fine as indicated, to any person committing an offence under Item 2 of this bylaw.
  - b. Notwithstanding a minimum fine which may have been established in a bylaw, the Fine Notice shall require the person to pay to the City of Dauphin the amount set out in Item 3 of this

Bylaw as a fine within 30 days of the alleged offence and the method of payment shall be as set out on the Fine Notice.

- c. If payment of the fine is not made within 30 days if issuance, the outstanding debt may be added to the property taxes. In addition to all other rights of collection that the City may have at law, such amounts may be collected by the City in the same manner as a tax may be collected or enforced under *The Municipal Act*.
- 5. A designated officer may issue a warning on the Fine Notice, for which no prosecution will be carried out and no fine will be levied.
- 6. Where a contravention, non-compliance, improper compliance, or partial compliance continues for more than one day, the person is guilty of a separate offence for each day it continues.
- 7. This bylaw shall be in force starting January 1, 2017.
